COUNCIL POLICY 11.5

POLICY TITLE: <u>ENERGY EFFICIENCY IN CITY-MANAGED FACILITIES</u>

POLICY STATEMENT:

The City will strive to implement General Plan Policy 5.1 (from the Energy Section of the Environmental Quality Element of the General Plan), which is reiterated below, to the maximum extent feasible, taking into consideration aesthetics and function of the area.

It is the City's goal to meet or exceed all local and State standards for energy conservation and use in all City operations providing ongoing energy management of City operations, including monitoring energy use, rate analysis, energy accounting and reports, technical support for energy-related departmental purchases, replacement of lights with high-efficiency tubes and ballasts and also replacement of older, inefficient (ozone-depleting) heating, lighting, ventilation and air conditioning systems.
