

City of Santa Cruz Calculation of Admission Tax

A tax on the price of admission or registration for events at the Police Department Community Room must be paid at the conclusion of the activity (see <u>City Ordinance 3.36</u>). The cost of this fee is 5% of net receipts for all entrance fees regardless of organizational type (including non-profits). This form is provided as a convenience by the Santa Cruz Police Department to assist you in calculating and submitting the payment of the tax to the City of Santa Cruz.

Remittance of the *Admission Tax* is due within 10 days of the event. If payment is made after 10 days but before 30 days, a 10% penalty is applied. If payment is made after 30 days from the event, an additional penalty of 15% is applied. Interest is applied to the ending balance each additional month, at a rate of 1.5% per month, after the first 2 months of not receiving payment.
