

CITY OF SANTA CRUZ Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration

The Administrator of Environmental Quality of the City of Santa Cruz is preparing to issue a Mitigated Negative Declaration of environmental impact for the following proposed project:

Project: Encinal Street Minor Land Division **Application No:** CP-18-0125

Project Location: 600 Encinal Street (APN 001-251-01) in the City of Santa Cruz, California

Project Applicant: Coastal Asset Holdings, LLC

Project Description: The proposed project consists of a Tentative Map to create a minor land division, Slope Variance, Minor Modification to V-59-11, and Residential Demolition Authorization Permit to divide an existing parcel into four parcels, to allow for a driveway within a slope exceeding 30 percent, and to allow for the demolition of one existing dwelling unit.

Significant Effects on the Environment: Biological Resources, Geology and Soils, Hydrology and Water Quality, Utilities and Service Systems

The Administrator of Environmental Quality of the City of Santa Cruz has reviewed the proposed project and has determined that the project, with mitigation measures as conditions of project approval, will not have a significant effect on the environment.
