

RESOLUTION NO. NS-27,559

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA CRUZ RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. NS-25,301 AND ADOPTING A NEW FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING & COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Cruz adopts fees and charges for planning, building and other land development permits and reviews to recover costs incurred by the City for the performance of those duties; and

WHEREAS, those fees and charges are regularly increased through cost of living and valuation adjustments, or by action of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, additional adjustments are required to both maintain cost recovery while reducing the regulatory costs of land development in the City of Santa Cruz.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Santa Cruz that Resolution No. NS-25,301 is hereby rescinded and a new Planning & Community Development Fee Schedule, as shown on Exhibit "A", attached and made a part hereof, hereby adopted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Santa Cruz that a new technology surcharge of 5% will be assessed on all other planning and building permit fees and charges, except duplication, General Plan Maintenance Fees, Traffic Impact Fees, Parkland Dedication Fees, Inclusionary Housing In-Lieu Fees, other development impact fees, and any project with total fees and charges less than \$100. These fees will be used to partially offset the costs of new planning and building technology not currently covered in existing fees, including a permitting system, document imaging and field access technology; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Santa Cruz that the General Plan Maintenance Fee will be reduced by 5% as of July 1, 2007 and another 5% January 1, 2008, with a new fee cap per project of \$250,000 or the total of all building permit fees, whichever is less, and the Green Building Fee will be maintained with a new fee cap per project of \$50,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Santa Cruz that City development impact fees, including the Traffic Impact Fees and the Parkland Dedication Fees, may be deferred for collection up to the issuance of the certificate of occupancy for each project, subject to any increased fees and the determination by the Director of Planning & Community Development of adequate security, credit or property recordation to ensure final payment of the fees; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Santa Cruz that the Inclusionary Housing In-Lieu Fees to be paid for partial unit obligations shall be charged at 80% of the full valuation.
