  - Bicycle event, bikes were stolen off car right in front of the house [
  - Can't leave anything out because it will got stolen
  - Would be nice to have more secure developments
  - Bothered by people scavenging trash and recycling, making a mess
  - Everyone sees homeless. If we could create a refuge, everyone would feel safer
  - Don't want to call homeless criminals because that is discrimination
  - Don't feel safe walking at night as a woman, people living on street will yell ugly things at them
  - Apartment complex is on homeless route, camps behind development
  - Every year the city comes to clean up but they get back
  - Sometimes there is violence between homeless and laborers
  - Mostly safe during the day but not when people are scavenging
  - Lots of drug deals in the street
  - Access to bathrooms is difficult if elderly or disabled
  - Need more units that are ADA accessible
- 2. Which of these 7 styles do you prefer? Why?
  - #1 on the left. Its safe has parking underneath. #1 on right not a good use of space
  - #5 on right is not too high, and its beautiful
  - When there is earthquake, less tall is less dangerous
  - Taller buildings tend to have narrower units
  - Elevators mitigate building height concerns but still prefer shorter buildings because of unit narrowness
  - #3 is good but prefer buildings with one level
  - On large streets, #6 is good because its closed off. it has nice balcony, would have nice views. looks safe
  - #5 is good looking too
  - Safety is main issue
  - Prefer developments with secure common areas (closed from public)
  - Prefer private open space, but also to have open space for kids
    - o Playground/ garden for kids

- 3. What types of uses would you like to see along Ocean, Soquel, Mission, and Water on the ground-floor?
  - Beauty salons, shops, restaurants
  - All types of personal services
  - Open space, courtyard, garden
  - Places for elderly community spaces
  - Its ok to have ground floor apartments
    - o But, if residents don't behave then there will be lots of bikes, trash on ground floor
- 4. What types of features do you prefer and why? To make space for these types of features, would you support a bigger front setback or inset ground floor?
