I beleive it may not be appropriate to attach a specific project such as the Broadway-Brommer bicycle path project to the Arana Gulch Master Plan.

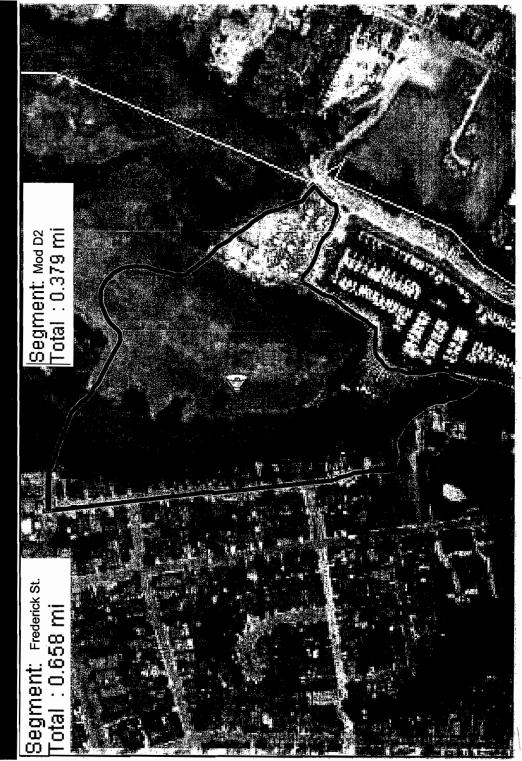
However, if that objection is not upheld, I believe that the Frederick Street Park route should have been considered in comparison to the prefered alternative.

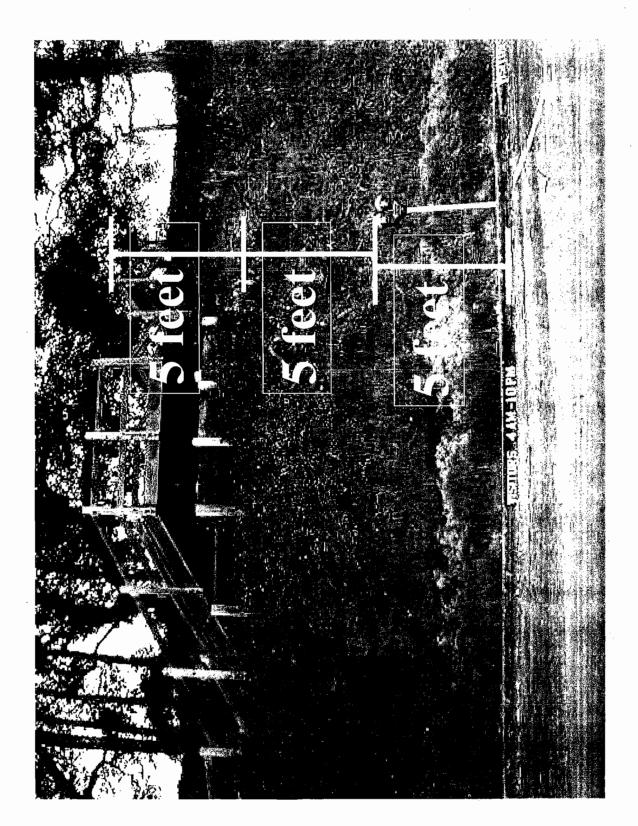
