
## Co-Rec Rules

- A. Unless otherwise stated, A.S.A. Official Softball Rules govern league play.
- B. The home team will provide scorekeeper. Home team forfeits any right to protest if they don't supply a scorekeeper. If the visiting team is then not able to provide a scorekeeper they also forfeit any right to protest.
- C. Limited Substitution Rule: A.S.A. re-entry rule is in effect. Unlimited EPs will be allowed in slow pitch.
- D. League games are played with a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 10 defensive players.
- E. No team may start or continue a league contest with less than 8 batters.
- F. Extra players may share a spot in the lineup and bat altenatively within the shared lineup spot.
- G. Game balls will be provided by the department and following each game the balls are to be returned to the officials.
- H. Pitching arc: 6' to unlimited.
- I. Players may add players to the line up, at the end, until the batting order has been completed one time. When a game is started with eight or nine players, teams may add up to the 10th spot throughout the duration of the game.
- J. No players shall intentionally run over an opposing player. Penalty for such an infraction will be automatic ejection from the game and suspension.
- K. NO METAL CLEATS MAY BE WORN. Rubber cleats are permissible.
- L. The veer line will be used at home plate. When a base runner passes the commit line they MUST continue to home and stay on the outside of the veer line until their foot has touched the home plate <u>line</u> or the ground past the line. The runner will be automatically called out if they touch home plate or go inside the veer line. The defense may not make a tag play on the runner who passed the commit line as all plays at the plate are force plays. In the event of an over-the-fence home run, the baserunners don't need to veer.

## Co-Rec Softball: Rules Additions

(To be used as a supplement to "Adult Softball Rules")

- M. Courtesy runners are allowed in slowpitch. The player who was the last out must be used as the courtesy runner. In the event that this player is unavailable, the previous out will be used and so on
- N. Harvey West Park: If a fair batted ball rolls up the hillside and out of play on Field 6, it will be ruled a home run.
- O. Harvey West Park: If a fair batted ball touches another player in the opposite field, the ball is alive and playable.
- P. Sliding is allowed.
- Q. 12" ball will be used.
- R. Count is 4 balls, 3 strikes, and will start with a 1-1 count. Once the batter has 2 strikes and hits a second foul ball the batter will be called out.

## Miscellaneous Information

- A. No schedule changes are allowed. If a team has a special problem in regards to game time, the manager should note the problem on the manager's card.
- B. Uniforms or matching shirts are highly recommended and are required for all A.S.A. tournaments.
- C. RAINOUTS: Manager should call 420-5265 x1 after 3 p.m. if in doubt as to the status of the game. Site supervisor should contact managers for Sunday rainouts.
