## ANALYSIS OF POLLUTANTS IDENTIFIED IN SECTION 307(A) OF THE CLEAN WATER ACT, POLLUTANTS CONTRIBUTING TO UPSET, INTERFERENCE AND/OR PASS-THROUGH

This section comprises of a summary of the reviews and the data sources used to evaluate the effectiveness of the pretreatment program to identify pollutants contributing to upset, interference and/or pass-through in 2015.

Analyses of the compliance monitoring data compiled for the NPDES permit in 2015 were undertaken for the purposes of evaluating pollutants identified in section 307(A) of the Clean Water Act for evidence of pass-through. In addition, unit process performance data, including microbiological examinations of secondary treatment stages, and specific physico-chemical data on digester health and performance were reviewed to provide the underpinnings of this segment of the report.

i. **Data from NPDES data review:** The annual review of plant effluent data showed that all receiving water quality based effluent limits (WQBEL) were met consistently in 2015.

These included all priority pollutants as well as the trace organic compounds that were measurable only through the deployment of semi-permeable membrane devices (SPMD) and other approved high volume integrative water sampling technologies deployed in the regional ambient monitoring program.

Therefore there was no evidence of pass-through from compliance monitoring data in 2015.

ii. **Unit process data review:** Plant performance at the end of the secondary process showed evidence of interference in 2015. In particular, the examination of secondary microorganisms based in microscopy revealed the abrupt overabundance of novel filaments capable of causing bulking in secondary clarifiers during the summer months. The Operations unit deployed treatment strategies that relied on different waste rates, and mass transfers to ensure that the elevated solids levels did not exceed the NPDES limits specified for the plant. The Inspectors reviewed trunkline practices, reviewed data and communicated with the major dischargers to ensure that the interference was contained.

iii. **Laboratory data analyses:** Laboratory data on solids (TSS) and organic load removal (TOC) together with the microbiological examination were reviewed within plant management. In conclusion, it was resolved that the interference was most probably caused by factors leading to high levels of nitrification and denitrification in the secondary process, and was linkable to a sustained influx of higher than normal levels of nitrates in 2015. This conclusion was reviewed with the major discharger of nitrate into the facility, and with the County Sanitation District's Environmental Compliance program, who has direct oversight for the discharge from that source.

In addition, the laboratory created a program to monitor influent and process levels of nitrate as a part of the regular process monitoring program at the facility.

At the end of the year, the situation seems completely resolved.

## **SECTION V. 2015 FOURTH QUARTERLY STATUS REPORT**

This segment of the report contains the summary of the activities of the program during the fourth quarter 2015. The significant changes in the program during the quarter were mostly centered on the organization of a contract to update the Enforcement Response Plan as indicated in the segment of this annual report covering significant program changes. That project to update the Enforcement Response Plan will continue through the first quarter of 2016, and will be communicated to the Water Board before a final promulgation is made by the City Council in 2016.

The remainder of this segment covers the enforcement activities involving significant dischargers and discharge violations during the reporting period.

The remainder of this section includes the narrative and table summary for the industrial user(s) found to be in violation of the pretreatment program during the fourth quarter.

**City of Santa Cruz Pretreatment Program**

Fourth Quarter 2015, Summary Attachment

All dischargers were in compliance during the 4th quarter of 2015 with the following exceptions:

1. During the fourth quarter, a categorical industrial user, Persys Engineering, **(Persys)** violated the pH limit in its effluent by reporting a pH value of 10.25 units. The discharge limits for Persys Engineering are 5.0 to 10.0.

This exceedance was noted in a Warning Letter to the discharger, and the situation is now completely resolved.

2. During the reporting period, Santa Cruz Nutritionals **(SCN)** continued to discharge industrial wastewater laden with TOC and caffeine at levels higher than established local limits for the parameters in the Santa Cruz area. As reported in the preceding quarter the discharger was fined substantially, and made to install better engineering controls in September 2015. However the episodic detections of these pollutants remain a source of concern and are continually reviewed with the management of Santa Cruz Nutritional.

## **SECTION VII. PRETREATMENT PROGRAM CHANGES**

## PRETREATMENT PROGRAM CHANGES

**There were several consequential pretreatment program changes in 2015, and the most notable two are the following:**

1. Implementation of area-specific analytical parameters to characterize unpolluted waters and waterways in Santa Cruz. The pretreatment program in cooperation with the laboratory and storm water programs collected analytical data from storm drains, creeks and lagoons in the area to determine the average and acceptable levels of specific pollutants associated with domestic sewage.

It was resolved that a certain threshold of TOC (Total organic carbon); Caffeine; and fecal indicator bacteria can be prudently utilized to determine when domestic wastewater and/or industrial wastewater has affected the water quality in area rivers, creeks and storm drains. This was used effectively to detect industrial waste discharged into Arroyo Seco Creek during the last year. A technical presentation of this work is scheduled to be presented at the CWEA Annual Technical Conference in Santa Clara in April 2016. The presentation is titled: *“Implementing trace chemistry to identify sewage pollution in storm water and surface waters”*. The paper will be presented at the section of the conference with the theme of **“Pretreatment, Pollution Prevention, and Stormwater: Tackling the Many Challenges.”**

2. Updating the Enforcement Response Plan: The Environmental Compliance program solicited engineering firms to update the City's Enforcement Response Plan in 2015. The reasons and need for the update had accrued over the years, firstly to more fully incorporate the provisions of the EPA streamlining rules promulgated in 2009, and further to broaden the enforcement guidelines to incorporate the City's ordinance changes regarding the management of private sewer laterals. In addition, and because of the role of the program in monitoring the City's stormwater infrastructure and ordinance, the ERP needed an effective update. The updated ERP will also more firmly identify the authority of the Senior Environmental Compliance Inspector to exercise the administrative functions in compliance enforcement.

## **SECTION IX. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

## PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The following section consists of a few highlights of the public outreach and public participation events of the Pretreatment program staff and management in the year 2015:

1. The annual publication of significant violators for 2014, as required by 40 CFR403.8(f) (2) (vii), was accomplished in January 2015. One industrial user violated the pretreatment program elements to the status of SNC for 2015. An image of the local newspaper page containing the publication and a copy of the proof of publication for the SNC will be included within the next communication to the Water Board.
2. Program staff and management participated in activities marking Pollution Prevention Week in September 2015. Program activities highlighted and celebrated the dischargers and businesses that created the momentum for the initial success of the citywide efforts to remove unwanted pharmaceuticals from the wastewater treatment system. Among those honored were:
  - a. the author of SB966, the Statewide legislation that allowed municipal efforts at controlled diversion of pharmaceuticals, Joe Simitian;
  - b. the Santa Cruz Police Department;
  - c. a local Pharmacy Horsnyder's Pharmacy and
  - d. two retired civil servants Chris Moran, City of Santa Cruz and Jeffery Smedberg, County of Santa Cruz.

The City also recognized Food Service Facilities and Vehicle Service Facilities that had consistently contributed to maintain the integrity of the Sewer system by subscription to the BMPs encoded in our Clean Ocean Business program. These businesses had also been publicized in the largest circulation social weekly, Good Times, earlier in the year. A copy of the page is embedded in this segment of the annual report.

3. The Pretreatment program commissioned and created vehicle decals for the advertisement of FOG management and information on biodegradable wipes in 2015. The vehicle decals are prominently displayed on the City's Vector trucks, and their pictures are shown below the narrative segment of this section of the report. In addition the program commissioned and distributed trifold in Spanish and English on items that pose a threat to the sewer system in daily use. Copies of one of those brochures in English and Spanish are embedded immediately below this panel.
4. Environmental Compliance program staff and management participated at the annual Public Works Day in May 2015. The program events focused on sustainable practices in the watershed and community.

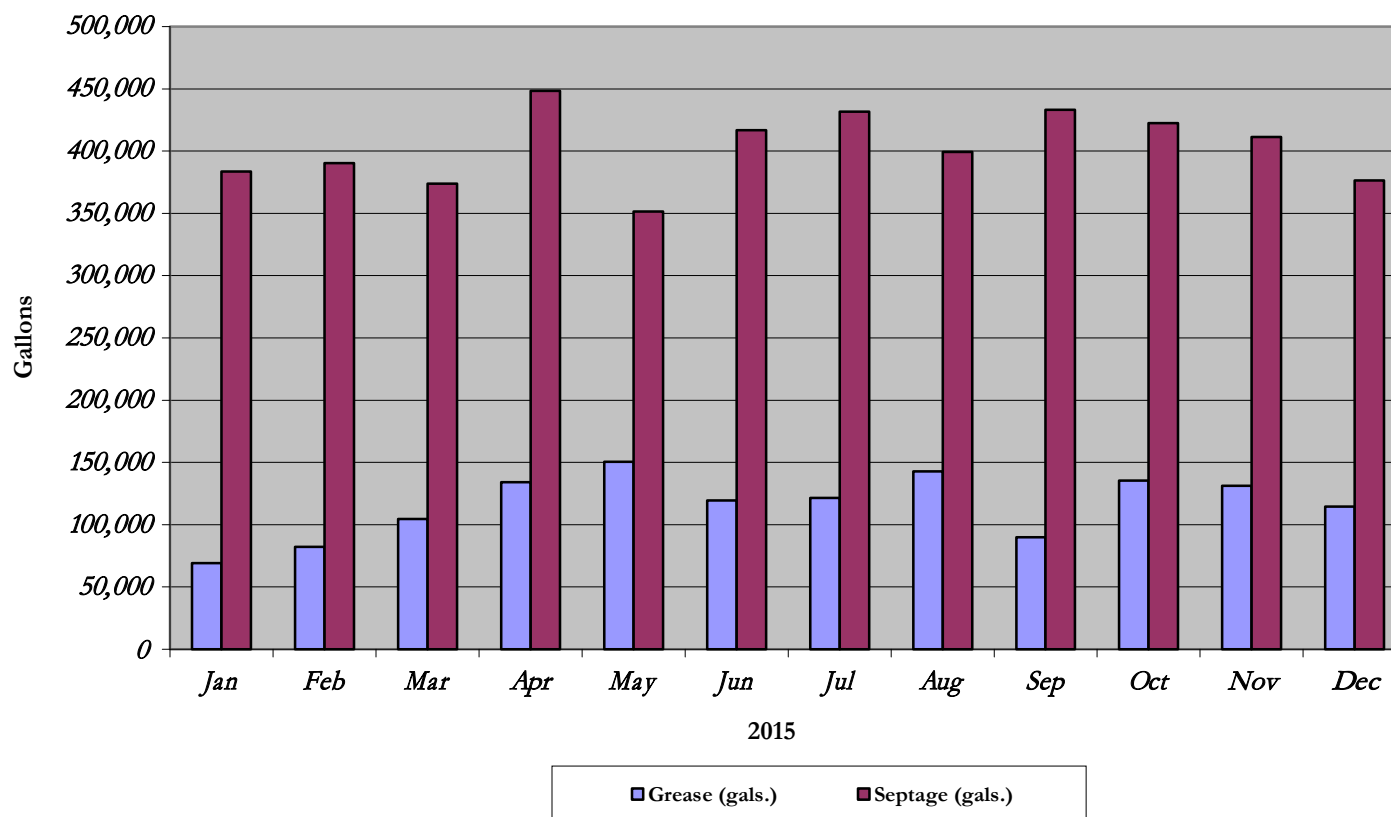



## PROGRAM SUMMARY

The Santa Cruz County Sanitation District (SCCSD) owns, operates, and maintains a sanitary sewer system that serves a portion of the unincorporated areas of Santa Cruz County. The SCCSD sanitary sewer system facilities include approximately 188 miles of gravity sewers, 14 miles of force main, and 35 pump stations. The SCCSD does not own nor is it responsible for maintenance or repair of any portion of the sewer service laterals. The District collects and transmits all sewage to the City of Santa Cruz for treatment and discharge.

The pretreatment program operates under the environmental compliance unit of the Santa Cruz County Sanitation District (District). The District continues to monitor all existing and potential commercial and industrial users by questionnaire, inspection, surveillance monitoring, and compliance sampling when necessary. Industrial users are inspected once per year unless items are identified during the first inspection, document review or correspondence that require follow-up. Compliance sampling by pretreatment program staff of Significant Industrial Users (SIUs) occurs twice per year at a minimum. The Sanitation Districts' pretreatment program has been fully implemented for many years. However, improvements are always being made to ensure the program's continued compliance and efficiency.

The District continues to implement a successful Fats, Oil and Grease (FOG) program and maintains compliance with the District's Sanitary Sewer Management Plan (SSMP). Food facility inspections were conducted by the environmental compliance staff throughout the year. Increased efforts were aimed at reducing grease related Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSOs) and stormwater pollution caused by commercial establishments. In addition, District pretreatment inspectors review architectural plan sets for new restaurants to ensure implementation of Sewer Use Ordinance requirements for grease control devices.

There were many changes in business ownership and several new businesses this year. Some of the new users were identified to be in the light industry category. Initially those businesses will be inspected annually and will not be subject to pretreatment sampling requirements, however; during annual inspections, the environmental compliance inspector will be able to determine if operational changes warrant future pretreatment sampling requirements.

All of the Significant Industrial Users were inspected and sampled by the District. There were no SIU violations this year and no SIUs in significant non-compliance. The District continues efforts to reduce violations through communication, education, on-site inspections, and public outreach.

Pretreatment inspectors educate light industries operating in Santa Cruz County on process-specific pollution prevention and waste minimization opportunities. During inspections, Best Environmental Management Practices (BEMPs) pamphlets and demonstrations for each particular industry are conveyed to business owners, managers, and employees. BEMPs have been developed for vehicle service facilities, dentists, photo processors, restaurants, dry cleaners, printers, machine shops, surfboard manufacturers, paint contractors, mobile carwash businesses and medical facilities. In an effort to reduce Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSO), the District developed outreach



material that highlights the problems with flushing fats, oil and grease and non-dispersible wipes down the sewer.

The Districts laboratory successfully went through the recertification process required by the Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program (ELAP).

In accordance with State Pretreatment Program requirements, the District continued to follow its Enforcement Response Plan to better effect compliance of all significant offenders of the District's discharge standards. Consequently, the District is prepared to bring repetitive non-compliant dischargers before the Board of Directors for the appropriate assessment of penalties.

2015 FOURTH QUARTERLY REPORT SUMMARY

The Santa Cruz County Sanitation District performed routine inspections of the Significant Industrial Users currently operating within the District and performed additional routine inspections of light industries and the food service industry.

No Significant Industrial Users were in violation of pretreatment regulations this quarter. A table for the fourth quarter results is provided as attachment A.

The District continued its public outreach and education program targeting residential sources of sewer stoppages caused by flushing non dispersible items.

## **Pretreatment Reporting Requirements NPDES Permit No. 0048194**

### **Results of Sampling Analysis**

The District pumps its effluent from the D.A. Porath Pump Station at 2750 Lode Street, the last pump station prior to the force main, to the City of Santa Cruz Water Pollution Control Facility (SCCWPCF) at 110 California Street. The data provided by the City of Santa Cruz represents the combined flow from the City and outlying District areas and meets the requirements of the NPDES permit. Please refer to the annual report for the City of Santa Cruz for analytical results pertaining to the NPDES permit requirements.

### **Upset, Interference, or Pass-Through Incidents**

There were no upsets, instances of interference, or pass-through incidents caused by the District's industrial users discharges.

### **Baseline Monitoring Reports (BMRs)**

When a potential discharger of industrial wastes has been identified, an industrial wastewater application and survey is sent to that potential discharger. After the completed application has been returned and subsequently reviewed by the environmental programs coordinator, the decision is then made whether or not to require baseline testing and/or wastewater permitting. Existing permitted industries are semi-annually reviewed for baseline monitoring requirements. The need to submit new baseline monitoring reports is determined for all non-categorical industrial dischargers at that time.

There were many changes in business ownership and a few new businesses this year. Several new users were identified to be in the light industry category. Initially the light industry facilities will be inspected annually and will not be subject to pretreatment sampling requirements, however; during annual inspections, the environmental compliance inspector will be able to determine if operational changes warrant future pretreatment sampling requirements.

### **List of Industries, Standards that Apply, Noncategorical Industrial Users, and Compliance Status**

Industrial users listed in Table 1.1 are significant industrial users (SIUs) and businesses that require District special discharge permits. They have been identified either as an industry group, or as a single discharger having a potential impact on the wastewater treatment system. The District used its method of classification of industrial dischargers in accordance with the definitions and guidelines set forth in the Pretreatment Program Description, the Codified Federal Regulations, and the requirements of the NPDES permit. Table 1.2 details the District's local wastewater discharge limitations. Table 1.3 details any SIUs and permitted businesses that were added or deleted during

this reporting period.

### **Summary of POTW User Inspections**

Table 2.1 summarizes all inspections of restaurants and light industrial users during this reporting period. Table 2.2 presents a summary of sampling and inspection results for all SIUs and permitted businesses, including their name, address, and compliance status. Definitions for the descriptions in Table 2.2 are also provided.

All SIU and permitted dischargers are scheduled for inspection at least once a year, although most years they are inspected two times. In addition, the SIU dischargers must submit self-monitoring reports (SMR) to the District semi-annually. District personnel sample the effluent of SIUs at least two times per year. For special discharge permits, the industrial user must submit an SMR to the District annually.

Several light industries within the District are also subject to inspection. A report compiled from the District's pretreatment program database is included as Attachment B. The report contains a list of all facilities subject to inspection and/or monitoring. Ideally, facilities are inspected annually. Included are the names and addresses of all SIUs.

### **Summary of Compliance and Enforcement Activities**

There were no SIU violations during this reporting year.

There were several minor light industry violations such as stormwater discharges and improper grease management in restaurants. The District continues efforts to reduce these types of violations through communication, education, on-site inspections, and public outreach.

### **Pretreatment Program Changes**

The District hired a part-time extra help employee in October to do inspections of restaurants and light industry. An inspector position was vacant this year due to an extended leave of absence. The District intends to hire another full time employee early this year. There were no other significant changes to the pretreatment program during the 2015 reporting year.

### **Summary of Pretreatment Program Budget**

Table 3.1 presents a summary of expenditures and inventory. The Pretreatment Program budget was established at \$400,000 for this reporting period. Additionally, funds were set aside for public outreach totaling \$50,000 and \$10,000 for the Green Business Program. Funds for the pretreatment laboratory were established at \$25,000 for this reporting period. Revenue for the program is obtained from commercial and industrial user fees through the Sanitation District's Operating Fund.

**FOG Source Control Program**

The FOG Source Control Program is administered, along with the pretreatment program, by the Environmental Compliance Unit. The FOG Source Control Program has been in place since 1977. The program elements include:

**Residential FOG Control**

The residential FOG outreach program consists of advertising in local newspapers and mailers, as well as door hangers used in areas where known grease problems exist. The focus of the program is to educate residents and small businesses on the proper disposal of FOG and about the consequences of discharging grease and other harmful wastes into the sewer. Details of our pollution prevention

outreach for both commercial and residential can be found at our Public Works website:

Currently, the public outreach program contains several elements designed to help educate the public about FOG issues.

The “Think Before You Flush” pamphlet is distributed once a year or more often if residential areas are consistently having problems. This pamphlet details what is and what is not appropriate to send down residential sinks, and why these issues are important. The pamphlet explains in detail what causes FOG problems, how to reduce FOG loads on the sewer lines, and why it is important to eliminate FOG from sewer lines.

Additional public outreach materials include bilingual (Spanish and English) residential door hangers that are distributed to residential areas where sewer maintenance workers and repeat spills indicate there are FOG problems in sewer lines. As with the “Think Before You Flush” pamphlet, the door hangers identify the problems associated with FOG and how these problems can be mitigated. The door hangers state that there is a problem in the neighborhood where the door hangers are being distributed.

Twice a year SCCSD publishes an educational grease ad in several local papers to reduce residential sources of grease in our sanitary sewer. The ad is published before the holidays in order to reduce problems associated with grease from deep frying turkeys and details ways in which people can reduce FOG in sewers and properly dispose of cooking grease.

Every year in April, the District participates in Earth Day Santa Cruz. The event provides an opportunity for the District to educate children and the community about proper use of residential sewers. The event is attended by nearly 3,000 people.

#### Commercial FOG Control

All food service establishments (FSEs) must have pretreatment devices (grease interceptors or traps) on all drains from their kitchens. Grease interceptors or traps must meet sizing requirements and design criteria set forth by the District. All grease interceptors and traps must be maintained according to a pump schedule specified by the District Engineer. Invoices and manifests of pumping must be sent to the Environmental Compliance Unit as proof of maintenance. The maximum allowable pump schedule is every 180 days, but may be more frequent if necessary. All food establishments are inspected at least once a year.

Best Environmental Management Practices (BEMPs) requirements for food service facilities include installing screens on all sink drains used for dishwashing, eliminating the use of grease interceptor/trap additives, eliminating the use of garbage disposal units, scraping all plates prior to the primary rinse, and proper storage of used deep-fryer oil. SCCSD staff developed a bilingual “Restaurant Wastewater” BEMP pamphlet detailing appropriate ways to reduce the FOG loads on private laterals and the Districts’ sewer lines. It also details proper janitorial cleaning methods and differences between interior and exterior grease interceptors, and their maintenance requirements. The BEMP includes a list of local liquid waste haulers authorized to discharge at the City of Santa Cruz Wastewater Treatment Plant.

### **Summary of Public Participation Activities**

No industrial users were published in the newspaper for significant noncompliance during this reporting period.

Pretreatment staff continues to educate light industries operating in Santa Cruz County on process-specific pollution prevention and waste minimization opportunities. During audits, BEMP pamphlets and demonstrations for each particular industry are provided to business owners, managers, and employees. BEMPs have been created for vehicle service facilities, dentists, photo processors, restaurants, dry cleaners, printers, machine shops, surfboard manufacturers, paint contractors, mobile car washes and medical facilities.

District staff partnered with the City of Santa Cruz and local non-profits to hold an Earth Day event in April 2015. The event featured kids' activities while also disseminating adult environmental outreach. The event was zero waste and solar powered. Other attractions included compost workshops, vendors, public speakers, and music. The event was attended by nearly 3,000 people.

Significant effort has been focused on reducing Sewer System Overflows (SSOs), and (FOG) loading on sewer system. The goals of the FOG Control Program include a reduction of FOG related SSOs and FOG discharge prevention to the sanitary sewer and storm drain systems. Residential outreach continued as well. In an effort to further last year's FOG work and reduce SSOs, public outreach continued throughout this reporting period. Public outreach material includes a residential mailer, a door hanger and mainstream media advertisements. Additionally, pretreatment staff conducted training on sanitary sewer overflow spill response to District employees. The training emphasized response, containment, sampling and reporting.

The Monterey Bay Area Green Business Program continues to thrive. The Sanitation District has been a key task force member and coordinator since 2004. Goals of the green business program include promoting pollution prevention, waste minimization, and implementing best management practices that go above and beyond the regulatory standards. A task force consisting of multimedia regulators (stormwater, air, hazardous materials, as well as wastewater) and several non-profit organizations continues to meet quarterly to coordinate the program.

The District, in collaboration with other County and City agencies, was successful in implementing a pharmaceutical and sharps disposal program. The goal of the program was, and still is, to provide a convenient and permanent system to collect used sharps and unwanted pharmaceuticals in the County of Santa Cruz. The County established 30 convenient, widely publicized and well-known locations throughout the region for drop-off of sharps and pharmaceutical waste. The sites include pharmacies, a police station, a medical facility and all of the local household hazardous waste (HHW) facilities. The program, dubbed Sharp Solutions for Home Medicines, will continue to collect household medicines and sharps to reduce water pollution and public health risks. Through this program, large quantities of pharmaceutical waste and sharps have been diverted from improper waste disposal channels such as the sewer systems and storm drains.

#### **Conclusion**

The District continues to monitor all existing and potential commercial and industrial users by questionnaire, inspection, surveillance monitoring, and compliance sampling when necessary. There were several Light Industry violations such as improper grease management in restaurants and stormwater discharges.

No SIUs were in significant non-compliance.

District personnel continue to educate light industries operating in Santa Cruz County on process-specific pollution prevention and waste minimization opportunities. During audits, BEMP



pamphlets and demonstrations for each particular industry are provided to business owners, managers, and employees.

The District partnered with the City of Santa Cruz and several non-profits on public outreach events and programs during 2015. This included Earth Day Santa Cruz, an informational commercial for television about reducing grease in sewers, BEMP development, and continued diverting pharmaceutical waste from improper disposal through the Sharp Solutions for Home Medicines take back program. The District is also a key member of the Monterey Bay Area Green Business Program.

Finally, the District's Environmental Programs Coordinator and the Environmental Compliance Inspectors keep apprised of the developments of the pretreatment industry in order to effectively administer state and federally mandated programs. Staff also utilizes several online listservs to keep up to date with the most current information pertaining to pretreatment programs. In February, pretreatment program staff attended the "Pretreatment, Pollution Prevention, and Stormwater (P3S)" conference held in Napa Valley California by the California Water Environment Association (CWEA). The conference held training sessions on the latest pretreatment technologies, stormwater regulations, emerging contaminants and public outreach. US EPA Region VI officials provided current information on state and federal requirements for pretreatment programs and State Water Board Staff presented an overview of the SSO reduction program. Pretreatment program staff received continuing education units for attending the conference. Staff was able to fulfill continuing education requirements by attending the conference.

## DEFINITION LIST FOR TABLE 2.1

### **Inspections and Sampling:**

Scheduled: Scheduled inspections and monitoring are planned in advance with prior notice to the industry. The purpose of scheduled inspections and monitoring are: to collect information and obtain samples to evaluate industry compliance with wastewater discharge requirements; to identify changes in industrial processes that may affect the quality of the discharges and permit limitations; to maintain a cooperative, as well as regulatory, presence with the industrial community; to ensure that self-monitoring sample collection and preservation techniques are correct; and to verify self-monitoring report data.

Unscheduled: Unscheduled monitoring and inspections represent a random spot check to evaluate industry compliance. No advance notice is given. Unscheduled inspections are performed the same day as a discrete composite sample is collected and any operational changes or unusual incidents may be noted, if appropriate, in the field-sampling logbook. Unscheduled sampling may occur whenever an industrial user is suspected of having difficulties maintaining consistent compliance.

Demand: Demand monitoring and inspections are usually performed in response to a complaint or emergency situation. Most often these complaints are from POTW Laboratory or operations personnel who notice a change in the influent wastewater characteristics. Monitoring and inspections of this type are used to determine the nature, duration and hazard of the discharge, obtain samples to verify the source and constituents of the discharge, ascertain the necessary corrective actions needed to control or halt the discharge, initiate corrective actions, if needed, and document information for follow-up compliance or enforcement activities.

Industrial User Self-Monitoring: Industrial users are required, as part of their wastewater discharge permit, to perform self-monitoring of the wastewater discharged to the POTW. Frequency of self-monitoring is determined by considering the industry's past performance and compliance, the flow and constituents of the IU's discharge, the extent and number of problems in the POTW as a result of industrial discharges, new or additional pretreatment standards and requirements, and the seasonal production schedules at an industry.

Compliance: A minor violation is a violation by an industrial discharger which exceeds the specific limitations for wastewater discharges set forth in the sewer use code or the applicable categorical pretreatment standard, but does not cause or create hazardous conditions for line maintenance or POTW personnel; does not cause an upset of the treatment processes, an interference with treatment processes, or a pass-through of pollutants to the receiving waters; does not damage the sewer collection or treatment system; and does not cause the POTW to violate its NPDES permit.

Enforcement: Enforcement procedures include a written/verbal warning, written letter of violation, administrative order from the District Engineer, infraction citation with fines civil action and criminal action. Chain of authority regarding enforcement procedures: The Industrial Waste Inspector samples industrial dischargers and investigates citizen complaints; and then reports the results of analyses or investigative findings to the Environmental Programs Coordinator. The Environmental Programs Coordinator, then, selects the appropriate enforcement in accordance with the District's Enforcement Response Plan. Actions brought before the District's Board are initiated by the Environmental Programs Coordinator. The Board and the District Engineer, as the Administrative Authority, make final decisions regarding fines and/or sewer service termination.
