

Information for Applicant Initiated Water Main Extension Agreements

Upon application for a water main extension, applicant must provide:

- 1. 5 copies of SCWD approved and signed engineered plans showing all proposed new water main(s), fire hydrants, fire and domestic water services and any other water facilities that may be required for the proposed development;
- 2. Engineers cost estimate for all proposed new water facilities;
- 3. Grant Deed with legal description of benefiting parcel(s) and mailing addresses of owner(s);
- 4. Building Permit and or Planning Department approval;
- 5. Recorded Subdivision Map or Tentative Map with County approval and
- 6. Any Encroachment permits and or Utility Easement/Right-of-way as required.

The Water Department will prepare the agreement for signature of owner(s), Contractor and City Officials. Prior to construction, Contractor's Insurance Certificates and Bonding must be provided and project inspection/plan review fees must be paid, as described in the agreement. All projects are subject to Water Conservation plan review and requirements.
