City of Santa Cruz Water Department NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT

PROJECT TITLE: Newell Creek Dam Inlet/Outlet Replacement Project

The City of Santa Cruz as the Lead Agency has prepared a Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the Newell Creek Dam Inlet/Outlet Replacement Project (Proposed Project) pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act.

PROJECT LOCATION: Ben Lomond in unincorporated Santa Cruz County

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Proposed Project consists of the replacement of the existing aging Newell Creek Dam inlet/outlet works in a new location at the Loch Lomond Reservoir and other associated improvements.

ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS: The Draft EIR found that implementation of the Proposed Project may result in potentially significant environmental impacts to: biological resources, cultural resources, forest resources, hazards and hazardous materials, and hydrology/water quality, which would be reduced to less than significant with mitigation measures identified in the EIR.
